What will my dancer wear?:

Dancers will wear their costumes for dress rehearsal and for their performance on May 14th. We do require certain classes to wear tights. Please purchase tights at our front desk so they will all match for their performance. Tights are \$7-\$9, depending on size.

Recital Pictures: April 18th-21st at Goc’s Creative Images

Recital pictures will be taken by Goc’s Creative Images, located at 571 S 33rd Ave, Columbus, NE 68601 on April 18th-21st. Individual and group pictures will be taken for each class and competition group.

Backstage Help:

We still need help backstage! Backstage helpers and Ushers will NOT need a recital ticket. Room moms will be able to watch their dancer’s routine backstage after their assigned class is done performing, you will take the dancers back to their assigned dressing room. You can sign up to help backstage in the lobby!

Dress Rehearsal:

- ALL dress rehearsals are held at the Columbus Middle School auditorium on May 10th, 11th and 13th.
- Dancers will be required to wear their recital costumes for dress rehearsals.
- You will need to enter through the north east entrance. Guests remain in the lobby or auditorium, one parent and the dancer should proceed to the auditorium.
- Dressing rooms will be limited during dress rehearsals, so we ask that dancers come dressed and ready to go.
- Please arrive 30 minutes early so dancers can get stretched and ready for their rehearsals. We will also be taking group pictures right before their routine run through.
- When your dancer is done with their routine(s) at dress rehearsal, they are free to leave, same goes for recital.
- NO FOOD OR DRINK MAY BE BROUGHT BACKSTAGE OR IN THE THEATER - DRESSING ROOMS or LOBBY ONLY!!!!
- Please no flash photography during dress rehearsal or recital for the safety of our dancers.

RECITAL DAY!!

We will be having a 'Pre Show' for each recital. These will be soloist performed by our competition team members. The will be providing entertainment before the show begins.

The middle school doors will be unlocked 40 minutes prior to each show.

Saturday May 14th at 11am (Show A): **Dance Classes ages 6 & under** Dancers should arrive no later than 10:30am. ****If dancers are only in the second act, they can arrive 30 minutes after the show starts.**** **Auditorium doors will close 5 minutes prior to each show!**

Saturday May 14th 2:00pm Show (Show B): **Dance Classes ages 7 & up** Dancers should arrive no later than 1:30pm. ****If dancers are only in the second act, they can arrive 45 minutes after the show starts.**** **Auditorium doors will close 5 minutes prior to each show!**

Saturday May 14th at 6pm Show (Show C): **Dance Classes ages 7 & up** Dancers should arrive no later than 5:30pm. ****If dancers are only in the second act, they can arrive 45 minutes after the show starts.**** **Auditorium doors will close 5 minutes prior to each show!**

- Please arrive with hair and make-up done for RECITAL. Make sure to pack extra ponytails, hairspray, bobby pins etc., to retouch hair. Due to the stage lights, we suggest that dancers wear make-up. It is NOT required, but the stage lights can wash out your dancers and make them look as white as a ghost. To avoid this dancers should wear lipstick and blush. Mascara, eyeliner, eyeshadow and foundation is optional. Dancers can wear glitter in their hair or on their eyes, but please apply at home and not at the high school.
- You are NOT allowed to video tape during the recital, ONLY during the dress rehearsal. ***If you are caught video taping during the show you will be asked to leave. Please respect our request.*** We will have a professional videographer for two of our recitals: SHOW A & B. You will be able to purchase a recital DVD for Show A & B. The cost will roughly be \$40 per DVD. More info to come. If you order online now, you can save \$5 at mrvideoonline.com
- There will be a ten minute intermission during each recital. EXCEPT FOR SHOW A. You may only pick up your child if they are done dancing after intermission.
- If anyone must exit the theater during any of the shows for any reason, please do so between numbers.
- At the end of the recital, dancers are can be part of the final bow. We ask for dancers to head back stage during the last few numbers of the recital. After the recital, they will be dismissed from the stage.
- Dancers are allowed to bring personal belongings to keep them entertained, but please LABEL EVERYTHING. The school or iDance will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Dancers are allowed to bring food and water into the dressing rooms. We ask that they pick up after themselves and to keep snacks nut free and refrain from anything that will make a huge mess.
- HAVE A WONDERFUL PERFORMANCE! Your enjoyment, the student's safety and happiness is our primary concern. Please ask questions to clarify any of our request. We welcome your comments and feedback to help us help you and your dancer(s) have a wonderful recital weekend!

RECITAL TICKETS

Recital tickets will go on sale April 18th at 12:00pm. Seats will be assigned, therefore, everyone who will need a seat will be required to purchase a ticket. *****Auditorium Doors will close 5 minutes prior to each show. Anyone who enters the auditorium during the show will be assisted by the usher and will not be allowed to go to their seats until instructed.**
